# Day 1: Arrive in Johannesburg InterContinental OR Tambo Int. Airport

On arrival at O.R. Tambo International Airport, please clear customs and immigration and collect your luggage.

Please NOTE that South Africa immigrations require you to have two completely blank visa pages in your passport per entry; without this you will be denied entry.

"Airports Company SA has received a directive from SA Civil Aviation to implement restrictions on liquids, aerosols and gels for international flights, in line with the International Civil Aviation Organisation (Icao) recommendations. Passengers on all regional and international flights may take in their hand luggage through the security check-in, no liquids other than a maximum of 10 x 100ml bottles of liquids, aerosols and gels (LAGs), contained in a transparent plastic bag with a one-litre maximum capacity. LAGs include drinks, soup, syrups, creams, lotions, oils, perfumes, mascara, sprays, gels, contents of pressurised containers (deodorants and shaving foams), pastes (including toothpaste), liquid/solid mixtures and other items of similar consistency."

Proceed through into the Arrivals Hall where a representative will meet you, hand over further documentation and assist you to the Hotel.

The InterContinental Airport Sun is conveniently located 75m from the O.R. Tambo International Airport.

#### Day 2: Depart Johannesburg to Livingstone.

The World Health Organisation (WHO) has revised the Yellow Fever vaccination recommendations for Africa. The South African Department of Health has subsequently issued a statement that all travellers from South Africa to Zambia and travellers from Zambia to South Africa will now require proof of yellow fever vaccination. Previously, this was not required.

All in-transit passengers between the two destinations, irrespective of the time period in transit, will also require proof of yellow fever vaccination.

As you will be entering Zambia, a single entry visa will be required and is obtainable at the point of entry at a cost of USD50.00 per person, payable in cash. The visa fee is subject to change at the discretion of the Zambian Government.

#### Zambian Visas Reminder

Clients traveling to Zambia are advised to please check that the visa is stamped into their passports before moving on from the immigration desk upon arrival. Clients should also double-check that they have been allocated the correct number of days for the duration of their visit or risk a fine which can amount to USD 250.00 per day that they overstayed.

On arrival at Harry Mwanga Nkumbula International Airport, please clear customs and immigration and collect your luggage. Proceed through into the Arrivals Hall, where a Sanctuary Sussi & Chuma Lodge representative will meet and transfer you to the lodge. The transfer time is approximately 30 minutes, subject to traffic conditions.

Non Premium brands of beer, spirits, wine, bottled water and soft drinks are included at all times.

#### Day 4: Embark on day and night game drives in the Luangwa Valley Sanctuary

Please meet the lodge representative in the reception area of the lodge for your transfer to Harry Mwanga Nkumbula International Airport. The departure time from the lodge will be advised to you locally. The transfer time is approximately 30 minutes.

Depart by Proflight scheduled light aircraft from Harry Mwanga Nkumbula Airport to Mfuwe Airport for (via Kenneth Kaunda International Airport). The flying time is approximately 2 hours and 45 minutes.

Please note that there is a luggage restriction on all Proflight flights within Zambia. Hand luggage is restricted to ONE piece at 11lbs (5kg) or less and checked luggage is restricted to 1 piece at 33lbs (15kg) per person.

#### Day 7: Journey to Lusaka

Depart by Proflight scheduled light aircraft transfer from Mfuwe Airport to Chiawa (Royal Airstrip) in the Lower Zambezi. The flying time is approximately 2 hours.

Kindly note, that all inter-camp flights are subject to multiple pick up and drop offs enroute to your destination which would affect the flying time. Depending on weather/airstrip conditions you may land at an alternative airstrip in the area.

The Chiawa Camp is simple and old fashioned, with traditional, thatched public areas and nine conventional guest tents with baths and outside showers.

All tents are under thatch, they have hot & cold running water, twin or double beds, insect screens and solar-powered lighting.

The safari tents are on raised timber deck with private verandas. Access paths to the tents run through a grove of Mahogany, maximizing guests' privacy.
